RES requires Winning Bidders to pay \$300 Winning Bidder Deposit
to help ensure purchase transaction is completed;
if Winning Bidder defaults, the \$300 Winning Bidder Deposit
is paid promptly to Consignor.

CONSIGNORS

- ✓ Consignor pays a non-refundable \$300 Consignment Fee when horse is entered.
- ✓ Consignor may set a reserve price.
- ✓ Consignor will use Consignment Form to enter information about the horse, and will need to upload photos, video link, and certain documents, such as the registration certificate; consignors are encouraged to upload any veterinarian exam reports. Helen Robertson [REOentries@RobertsonEquineSales.com or (502) 802-6777] is available to assist, if needed.

After the auction has closed:

- ☐ RES will collect funds from the Winning Bidder, beginning with the immediate \$300 Winning Bidder Deposit to help ensure purchase transaction is completed;
- ☐ After the horse has been paid for, RES's 5% sales commission will be deducted from Consignor's proceeds, unless the horse sells for less than \$2,000 in which case no sales commission will be charged;
- ☐ Consignor shall provide original breed registration certificate and transfer form to <u>breed registry's office</u> when horse is picked up;
- ☐ RES will promptly forward proceeds to Consignor.

If horse is not sold, Consignor may add horse to *Buy It Now* slot at RobertsonEquineOnline.com; no additional Consignment Fee will be charged. Upon request, RES will also provide highest bidder's contact information to Consignor. Consignor shall pay 5% sales commission to RES if horse is sold under *Buy It Now* offer.

ALL REGISTERED BIDDERS must

authorize a Winning Bidder Deposit of \$300 to the bidder's credit card on file when they begin bidding on a horse; this payment helps ensure the Winning Bidder will complete the purchase of the horse. In case

of Winning Bidder's default, the Winning Bidder shall forfeit the Winning Bidder Deposit to the Consignor. If Bidder does not win the highest bid, no charge will be made to bidder's card for Winning Bidder Deposit. If bidder becomes Winning Bidder, the \$300 Winning Bidder Deposit charge to Winning Bidder's credit card will occur immediately, and RES will forward to Consignor. When remainder of purchase price is paid to RES, the \$300 Winning Bidder Deposit will be credited to Winning Buyer's account by deducting it from final purchase price of horse.

For example:

- Winning Bidder pays \$300 Winning Bidder Deposit to RES immediately after close of auction;
- RES promptly pays \$300 Winning Bidder Deposit to Consignor;
- The \$300 Winning Bidder Deposit is deducted from purchase price of horse, which must be paid by Purchaser to RES within three (3) days of close of auction;
- If a bid is placed within five (5) minutes of the close of the auction, bidding will be extended by another five (5) minutes.

WINNING BIDDERS must:

- ☐ Pay sales tax on purchase or provide bidder's state's sales tax exemption certificate, commercial shipper's Bill of Lading, etc., to RES to avoid taxation;
- ☐ Forward remainder of funds (less \$300 Winning Bidder Deposit) to RES via credit card, wire transfer, or check within three (3) days of winning the bid;
- ☐ Make arrangements directly with Consignor to pick up the horse;
- ☐ Receive new registration certificate from breed registry's office (not from Consignor).
